Job Overview

Wolf Park is seeking a passionate and dedicated Behavioral Enrichment & Training Manager to join our team on a part-time basis. The ideal candidate will be responsible for developing and implementing a comprehensive behavioral enrichment plan and cooperative care-based training program for all species under our care. This role is crucial in promoting the physical and psychological well-being of our animals by encouraging species-appropriate behaviors and ensuring that all animal care staff are proficient in these practices.

Key Responsibilities

• Behavioral Enrichment Plan

- Develop a behavioral enrichment plan tailored to the needs of each species at Wolf Park;
- Ensure the plan encourages species-appropriate behaviors through a variety of enrichment activities provided at least daily;
- Collaborate with the animal care team to implement and refine enrichment activities, ensuring they are engaging, safe, and effective;
- Assesses and updates the enrichment plan based on animal responses and evolving best practices in the field at least quarterly.

• Training Program Development

 Design and develop a training plan rooted in Cooperative Care principles, focusing on creating positive, trust-based relationships between animals and caregivers;

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- Implement a cross-training program for all animal care staff, ensuring consistent training methods across the team within sixty (60) days of hire;
- Provide guidance and support to animal care staff during the implementation of training protocols;
- Evaluate the effectiveness of training programs and make adjustments as needed to meet the needs of both animals and staff.

• Collaboration & Implementation

- Work closely with the Executive Director and animal care staff to integrate the enrichment and training programs into daily operations;
- Assist in the hands-on implementation of enrichment activities and training sessions, serving as a resource and mentor for animal care staff;
- Provide ongoing education and support to staff to ensure adherence to the established plans and promote continuous improvement.

• Documentation & Reporting

- Maintain detailed records of enrichment activities, training sessions, and animal progress;
- Report monthly to the Executive Director on the status of enrichment and training programs, including successes, challenges, and areas for improvement.

Qualifications

- Proven experience in animal behavior, enrichment, and training with a focus on Cooperative Care;
- Strong understanding of species-appropriate enrichment and behavioral needs for a variety of species;
- Ability to create and implement detailed plans and protocols, with an emphasis on animal welfare;
- Passion for wildlife conservation, education, and animal welfare;
- Flexibility and adaptability to meet the dynamic needs of a diverse animal population.

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Working Conditions
